Challenges:

Tracking labor manually while their employees travel across the U.S. proved to be a source of inaccuracies and inefficiencies for Klinger Companies. In addition, Klinger Companies needed a solution that would scale to meet their expanding payroll requirements.

Solution:

Klinger Companies chose Austin Lane's ALMobile Time Tracking to eliminate the manual time sheets, streamline its overall time and attendance tracking process across 4 companies.

Why can't we enter time cards directly into our system?"

Klinger was determined to find the best solution to streamline their processes to obtain more accurate, real time information to achieve a competitive advantage. These motivating factors led Klinger to Austin Lane Technologies and to purchase ALMobileTM.

MANUAL PROCESS LEAD TO DISCREPANCIES, INACCURACIES, AND DUPLICATION OF WORK

Klinger processed paper time sheets that were completed manually in the field and collected from projects across 15 states. The payroll clerks had to receive and key in this information. Costs were charged to jobs based on these time sheets. A great deal of time was spent correcting the inaccurate data reported on paper time sheets.

According to Bob DeSmidt, CFO, "We had a lot of errors because managers would pick codes that might not have been associated with their job. We came across cost codes that were invalid and jobs that weren't set up. Some time sheets were submitted as spreadsheets via email, and these had to be rekeyed as well."

Klinger's payroll process was time consuming and lacked accuracy, making it all but impossible for Klinger to accurately track cost codes and other important job details. In addition, paperwork for newly hired employees would frequently be received late and incomplete, making it difficult to process their payroll timely and accurately.

UNWILLING TO COMPROMISE THEIR GOALS

In addition, the solution had to integrate with Sage 300 (Klinger's financial ERP system), be supportable by limited IT staff, and have outstanding technical support.

EMPOWERING FOREMEN WITH THE RIGHT TOOLS

Klinger utilizes both the mobile device and desktop versions of ALMobile since many of their jobs have networks at their job sites. Having both versions available provides field personnel greater flexibility to organize their processes as efficiently as possible. Some foremen enter time as it occurs real-time, while others enter at home in the evening.

"For our traveling companies", says the payroll manager, "this was a huge thing. They can enter time sheets daily. Our field personnel who use the mobile device, absolutely love them."

INCREASED ACCURACY AND QUALITY OF INFORMATION

At Klinger foremen might have sent in labor with cost codes that weren't set up or which didn't exist. This not only created additional work, requiring payroll to contact the foremen, but also inaccuracies because of the time lapse in performing the work.

"Now", says the payroll manager, "cost codes are set up for every job beforehand; it has eliminated a lot of accuracy issues. Cost code tracking is much better."
